## 1 Scribal Activity

### 1.1 General

During the reporting period a number of records were imported from the Canon database, updating scribes assignments to the end of February 2014, increasing the overall number of assignments to be completed.

During March – 30 records – updated until the end of February  
 These scrolls were given the status “Recently Imported” until it could be established whether or not the recipients have registered armoury. These were then updated with “on hold” or “available” categories.

The following assignments have been downloaded from Canon but not yet uploaded to the Scribes’ database:

During April – 7 records - updated until the end of March

During May – 20 records – updated until end April, including a number of assignments that were not available in Canon during the last download.

### 1.2 Lochac Scroll Challenge

Following the announcement of the Lochac Scroll Challenge interest in scribing, particularly illumination, continues to be encouraging with a number of new and interested scribes requesting assignments. Typical requests involve the new scribe requesting the illumination only while existing / more experienced scribes take on the calligraphy.

The backlog of AoAs waiting for assignment has dropped dramatically (please see figures above) with 49 AoA assignments requested since the beginning of the Challenge.

### 1.3 *Beginners' Kits*

Stocks for the beginners' kits are currently running low. A number of kits were requested following the commencement of the Lochac Scroll Challenge & will need to be re-stocked.
